THOUSANDS OF FREEMASONS GATHER IN ALEXANDRIA TO CELEBRATE THE CENTENNIAL OF THE 1923 CORNERSTONE LAYING OF THE GEORGE WASHINGTON MASONIC NATIONAL MEMORIAL

ALEXANDRIA, VA — The largest gathering of Freemasons in the twenty-first century will take place in Alexandria on Monday as Masonic leaders and members from all fifty states celebrate the 100th anniversary of the laying of the conerstone of the George Washington Masonic National Memorial ("the Memorial"), The Memorial is a towering monument overlooking Alexandria that was erected by the Masonic fraternity as a gift for all humanity, and which serves as a museum offers educational tours that explore George Washington's Masonic membership and the ways in which Freemasonry has been a part of American life. During this event, a re-enactment of the 1923 cornerstone ceremony will be publicly performed.
